

Two HEIs Adds To The Accreditation List and One To The Re-Accreditation List.

The University Grants Commission (UGC) recently awarded accreditation certificates to three institutions during a ceremony held at the UGC Seminar Hall on Falgun 9, 2080. UGC Chairperson Prof. Dr. Dev Raj Adhikari handed over the accreditation certificates to the institutions. UGC Secretary Prof. Shankar Prasad Bhandari, Rector Prof. Bhargav Dhital, Chairperson of Nepal Engineering Council Prof. Dr. Padma Bahadur Shahi, Dean of IOE, Tribhuvan University Prof. Dr. Shashidhar Ram Joshi, PRT Coordinator Prof. Dr. Mana Prasad Wagle and Dr Shiv Kumar Rai, PRT Member Prof. Ramesh Kumar Maskey, TU QAA Director Dr. Prem Bahadur Thapa, authorities from accredited institutions and UGC officials attended the award ceremony.

Mahakavi Devkota Campus founded in the year 2060 B.S, is situated in Sunwal-04, Nawalparasi (Bardaghat Susta West). Campus is affiliated to Tribhuvan University and is serving as a community-based educational institution. The campus offers Bachelor's programs in BBA, BICTE, BBS, B.Ed. and B.A. along with Master programs in Business Studies. The institution embarked on its re-accreditation journey by submitting a Letter of Intent (LOI) on Falgun 30, 2078. Subsequently, its Self-Study Report (SSR) received approval on Poush 22, 2079.

Among the awardees, Kathmandu Shiksha Campus, located in Chandragiri Municipality-10, Satungal Kathmandu was founded in 2048 B.S with affiliation to Tribhuvan University as a community-based educational institution. It offers Bachelor's Programs in B.Ed , BCA, BBS and Master's program in MBS and M.Ed. The institution initiated its accreditation journey by submitting a Letter of Intent (LOI) on Bhadra 26, 2071 got its SSR approved only during second submission on Magh 5, 2076.

Institute of Engineering, Thapathali Campus established in 2023 B.S, is a constituent institution located in Kathmandu -11, Thapathali Street, Nepal. It is affiliated to Tribhuvan University; the campus offers academic programs in both Bachelor and Master level. The journey of accreditation began with the submission of a Letter of Intent (LOI) and its acceptance on Bhadra 21, 2072. The Self-Study Report (SSR) of the campus was accepted on Shrawan 22, 2075.

Each institution embarked on its accreditation journey by submitting a Letter of Intent (LOI) and subsequently then went through several stages, including approving their Self-Study Report (SSR), Peer Review Teams (PRT) formation, undergoing assessment visits i.e. preparatory assessment visit and Final PRT Visit, and the submission of a response report based on the recommendation provided during the assessment. Following this the Educational Quality Assessment and Accreditation Council (EQAAC) recommended the UGC Board to award accreditation to the institution. The UGC Board decided to award accreditation to the institutions on Magh 11, 2080.
